

Level 3 BTEC Applied Design

Activities:

1. Choose a theme from the following:
 - Machines and mechanisms
 - Flora and fauna
 - Architecture
2. Carry out primary and secondary visual research from a number of sources.
3. Using your visual research, produce a number of art works, using a variety of media, to visually record source material on this theme. You should aim to produce a minimum of 10 drawings, sketches, photographs, etc.
4. Carry out research to identify a designer that uses a similar theme in their own work. Produce a written report about the designer. Include biographical details and information about their inspiration. You may also want to analyse and evaluate a piece of their work as art of your report. Illustrate with photographs to support your writing.
